Contacting Head of the Harbor Police-
Dial 911 and tell the dispatcher that you reside in the Head of the Harbor police district

Dear Residents,

During an emergency, we dial 911. However, if not an "emergency" some residents are reluctant to use 911 as we have been trained to think of 911 as only an emergency contact.

In Head of the Harbor, our village patrol officers are dispatched using the 911 system. If police are out on patrol, they are not in the station; and must be reached through 911. Please be assured that our community minded police officers and dispatchers will prioritize the calls.

If you see or hear something that might be out of the ordinary, please call 911. For example, a strange car parked on a village street or a person deer hunting in our jurisdiction, please call 911. If you see a tree blocking a road or downed electrical wires or a traffic accident, call 911. If you see someone acting dangerously, call 911. Please do not be reluctant to call.

For any time sensitive issue, do not call the police station, Village Hall or the Mayor. This will result in a delay. If you report something out of place in our village using 911, the police will be appreciative of the community involvement.

Our village enjoys safety from crime, and you can help with this. If you have any doubt about something you see, call 911. Your vigilance is a supportive action that can assist the police to protect our village community.
